THE PASTOR'S PLEA FOR PRAYER & PARTICIPATION

Perhaps you were fan of the weekly TV series in the 50's called The Andy Griffith Show in a small North Carolina community guided by Sheriff Andy and his bumbling deputy, Barney Fife. Their exploits included providing an open cell for the town drunk, Otis, and the town misfit, Ernest T. Bass. Occasionally, Sheriff Andy would need deputies to manage additional police work which might become necessary. Andy would have no choice but to "deputize" cousins Gomer and/or Goober or even Floyd the Barber. The additional resources served to safeguard the town when Andy needed their assistance.

During the weeks ahead, I call upon each of you for the additional resources of help, support, presence, prayer, and participation in the life of St. Andrew's. During my pending medical leave for my upcoming hip replacement, I ask for your commitment to St. Andrew's between now and the end of October. Let me suggest several ways in which your faithfulness is needed:

Presence and participation in worship: Between September 17 – October 29, Rev. Wayne Stretch, our Interim Moderator at St. Andrew's will either lead our worship or help supply a worship leader each Sunday. As we do each week, you will be called to worship, offer confession, and receive assurance that we are pardoned, hear beautiful music, and be led by scripture and sermon in living faithfully the Christian life.

Joint Worship Services planned for October 1, October 8 and October 16 with Trinity Presbyterian, Knox Presbyterian and St. Andrew's Presbyterian. The St. Andrew's Session voted to affirm the opportunity of worshipping together in each of our respective locations during the first 3 Sundays in October.

A shuttle will be provided from St. Andrew's on October 1 and October 15 to assist those from downtown to arrive for worship for the services at Knox and Trinity. The doors of St. Andrew's will be open on Sunday, October 1 and October 15 from 10:00 to 11:45 for Quiet Meditation and Music for any who may be visiting the downtown area looking for a worship service and unable to shuttle to the other locations. When Sheriff Andy asked for extra assistance during his tenure, so do I ask for your help, support, presence, prayer and participation in the life of St. Andrew's during the weeks that I am away on medical leave. One of our scriptures for this Sunday is:

ORANGE SHIRT DAY

Orange Shirt Day is an annual national event that is held on September 30th in Canada. It is a day to honour Residential School survivors and their families, and to remember those that never made it.

This is an event that grew from Phyllis Webstad sharing her story in 2013 of having her shiny orange shirt taken from her at the age of six when she arrived at St. Joseph Mission residential school. Her story created an opportunity for discussion on the aspects and experiences of the residential school legacy.

Local artist Bear Horne designed the the Victoria Orange Shirt t-shirts. Horne's design features a bear to help us follow the right path, an eagle to help us have a vision of a bright future, a hummingbird to keep our mind, body and spirit healthy, and a flower to feed the connection of all these elements.


