ROAD CLOSURES RVM Road Closures for Sunday are as follows: 12 to 6 pm Belleville to Oswego to Government, and Menzies to Belleville to Quebec. 3 to 9 pm Quebec to Oswego to Menzies. 5 to 10 pm Kingston to Montreal to Menzies, and Menzies to Quebec to Superior. There is no parking permitted on the race routes. Traffic personnel will assist you in crossing the route when it is safe. Please plan ahead and give yourself extra time to get to church!

PARKING Parking passes for the Broughton Square Parkade and the Sussex Place Parkade are available in advance at the church office, or in the narthex of the church on Sunday morning. Please ensure you are displaying your pass or you may be charged! City-owned parkades are free Sundays and on holidays. We also need **volunteer drivers**. If you can volunteer, please leave your name at our Church Office via phone or email as soon as possible.


Regular services resume Sunday Oct. 22nd.


Pastor Mitch will return from his medical leave on Sunday Nov. 5th.


SONGS OF THE DEAD

The period begins on 31 October and encompasses All Saints' Eve (Halloween), All Saints' Day (All Hallows') and All Souls' Day, as well as the International Day of Prayer, and Remembrance Sunday.
