Regular Worship Services Resume Sunday Oct. 22nd


Pastor Mitch will return from his medical leave on Sunday Nov. 5th.




Sharing news from the mission and ministry done through congregations in the newspaper is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate successes, encourage one another, and connect with people across the country.


