

The food hampers are put together by Mustard Seed Street Church, which runs a food bank and has commercial contacts that enable each dollar donated to be stretched to the max, to provide nutritious items for financially struggling families and individuals. Small Christmas gifts are included with each hamper along with enough food to feed 4 persons. This year the cost of filling a hamper for a family of 4 is approximately \$360. Smaller hampers are prepared for couples and single persons.

Later this week St. Andrew's cheque of all Share the Joy donations will be delivered to Mustard Seed Street Church Food Bank.




NEW CHURCH LOGO

By approval of Session, a Branding Task Group was formed in June 2022. The members were Jean Marcellus, Colina Titus, Sabine Teetzel, Cathy Mackenzie and Susie Henderson. A new logo for St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Victoria BC was approved by Session at their March 2023 meeting. Our Launch Date will be January 1, 2024.

We present to you:



RATIONALE for the CHOSEN DESIGN: The design approved by Session will mean different things to different people. Each time the Task Group looked at the design, they saw different things in each segment of the three components. Here are some of the examples the Task Group saw.

Green Hills at the Bottom: Our Journey with Christ as a Group, Walking Towards Christ, The Trinity, People Coming Together and Growing, A Personal Journey Towards Christ, A Journey from Different Backgrounds, Past, Present, Future, Two Criminals on Either Side of Christ, Represents Different Places of Origin Coming

Together, In Hebrew, the word 'three', shelosh/ sheloshah means harmony, new life, and completeness.

Tree: Tree of Life, The Cross, Continued Renewal, Different Seasons, Growth.

Leaves on the Tree: A Modern Symbol or Connection to St. Andrew's Stained Glass Windows, The People Within Our Congregation, New Growth, New Beginnings, Our Community, We All Come From Different Walks of Life.

The best thing about the new Branding logo is that it was created by one of our own – Finlay Henderson, elder son of Susie and Angus Henderson. Thank you, Finlay!!!!!
