PARABLE OF THE PASTOR

"Seek the Lord while he may be found; call on him while he is near" writes Isaiah the prophet in Isaiah 55:6.

What an appropriate invitation for Lent. Lent is a time to consider our relationship with God. These 40 days beginning on Ash Wednesday (February 14) allows us to look deeply within and consider the anxiousness that often pervades our living. Lent prepares us for Easter but not until we take seriously the opportunity of asking ourselves the powerful questions of Where and How does God fit into my life? What daily practices are not redemptive but are in fact destructive; physically, mentally, emotionally, relationally and spiritually?

Ash Wednesday begins a new opportunity to begin our Lenten preparation. Plan to attend:

Ash Wednesday Service, St. Andrew's, 12:00 Noon.

In the weeks following, consider a Lenten Study weekly with St. Andrew's and Knox participating:

Using the Lectionary scripture passages for each Sunday in Lent: We gather at Knox Presbyterian on Wednesday, February 20, 27, March 5, 12, 19 and 26. Each week we will use the ancient spiritual practice of lectio divina to listen to each of the Lenten passages for the coming Sunday. Study is from 11:30-1:00. Bring a sack lunch and engage in spiritual listening to scripture as we prepare for the Sunday's in Lent.

Praying that each of you will prayerfully consider participating in these Lenten opportunities.

EMAIL SECURITY

Our email address is the door many knock with the hope that we, inadvertently, let them in. Below some tips on the subject:

"Be present" when reading an email: if you do not know the sender, and something does not make sense, check with friends or family, do not reply if you do not know them; do not engage with them in any way.

Report it as spam: if after checking, the sender is unknown and suspicious, treat it as spam, until you hear otherwise (you can go to the spam folder and mark it as "Not spam" later). Until then, mark it spam. Example: Gmail

Keep your systems updated: your operating systems, web browsers, your apps in your large, medium or mobile devices should regularly be updated. Updated systems provide more protection.

Keep your inbox and contact list filtered and updated: current email apps filter your emails by default but you train your system who to open the door to. Known senders should be in the inbox, the others can live in the junk.

No system is foolproof, but, by getting familiar with these topics, updating your devices, and being mindful when engaging by email, you will have an edge.
