As part of a Caring Community Initiative, the Presbyterian Music Camp piloted a Mental Health Workshop program during the summer of 2023.

The program included mental health support and workshops run by a qualified health professional on the topics of anxiety, depression, ADHD, self-harm, suicide and other mental health topics.

The opportunity for attendees to express themselves in a caring and safe environment with professional leadership took safety to the next level for the camp, and provided an opportunity for individuals to explore some of their struggles with support.

The program continues to grow by providing Mental Health First Aid training to staff and volunteers as well as exploring ways that art and music therapy can be offered in a camp setting.

GAZA CEASEFIRE PILGRIMAGE

Greetings to Greater Victoria Communities of Faith,

Many people in Victoria from various groups and as individuals have expressed anguish with the suffering in Gaza and Israel since October 7, 2023. A small group within Broad View United, a congregation of the United Church of Canada, has struggled with ways to respond when our hearts feel broken as members of the global family.

Along with other United Church congregations, we have decided to accept a global invitation by a network of Christian organizations and churches with shared convictions who are engaging in a prayerful show of solidarity around the world. During Lent (Feb. 14- March 28) people have been asked to walk the 'length of the Gaza strip'. On this Gaza Ceasefire Pilgrimage, participants will, with their own bodies, prayerfully map Gaza onto their towns and cities.

We invite you and others of your faith to join us in this global action by participating in a pilgrimage walk for a ceasefire in Gaza here in Victoria on Saturday March 16th. 
